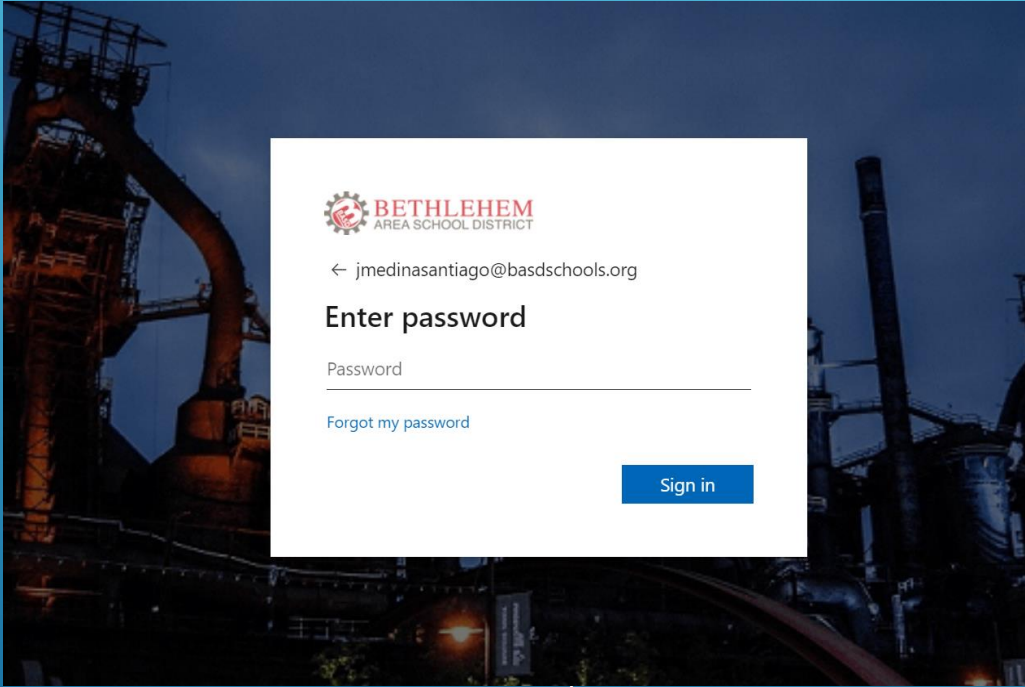
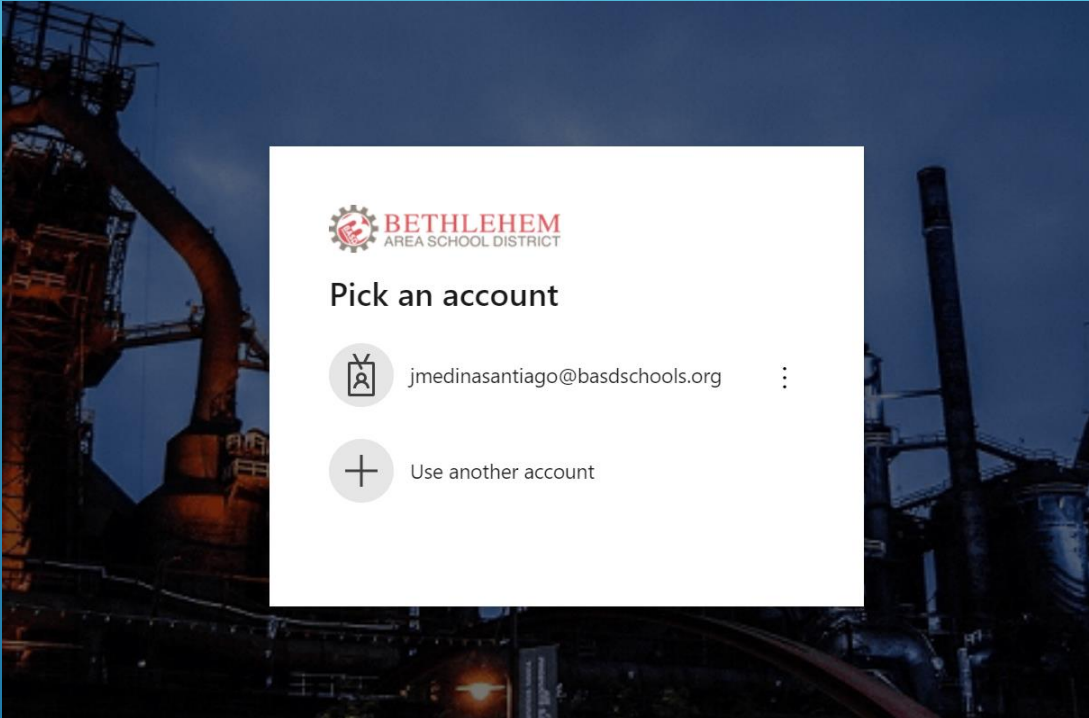
Helper Helper uses the single sign-on system. You'll use your BASD email, along with your existing password to log in. You can utilize the mobile app or web app.

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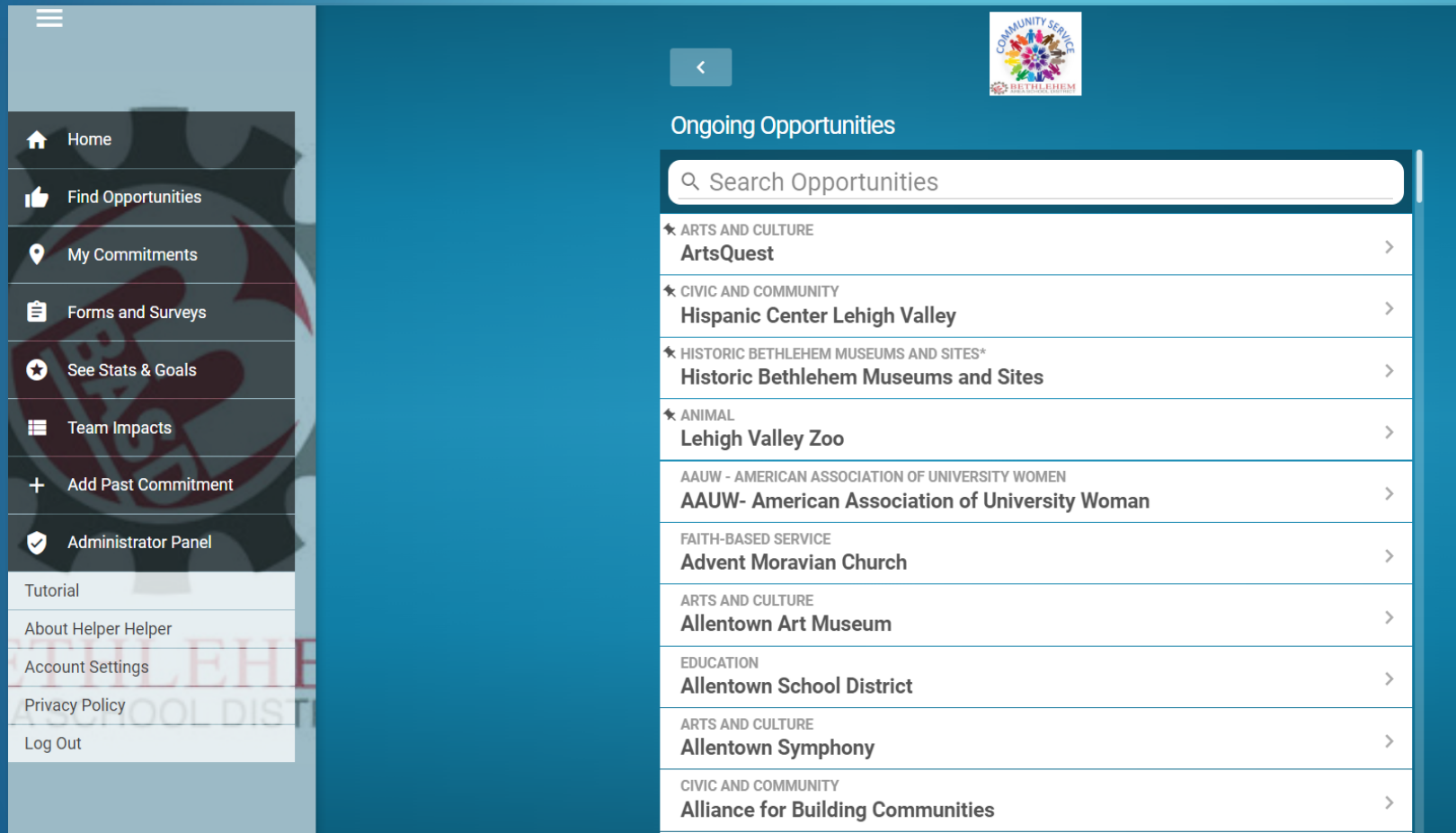

Under “Ongoing Opportunities” you will see a list of organizations that offer volunteer service, as well as specific events you can sign up for.

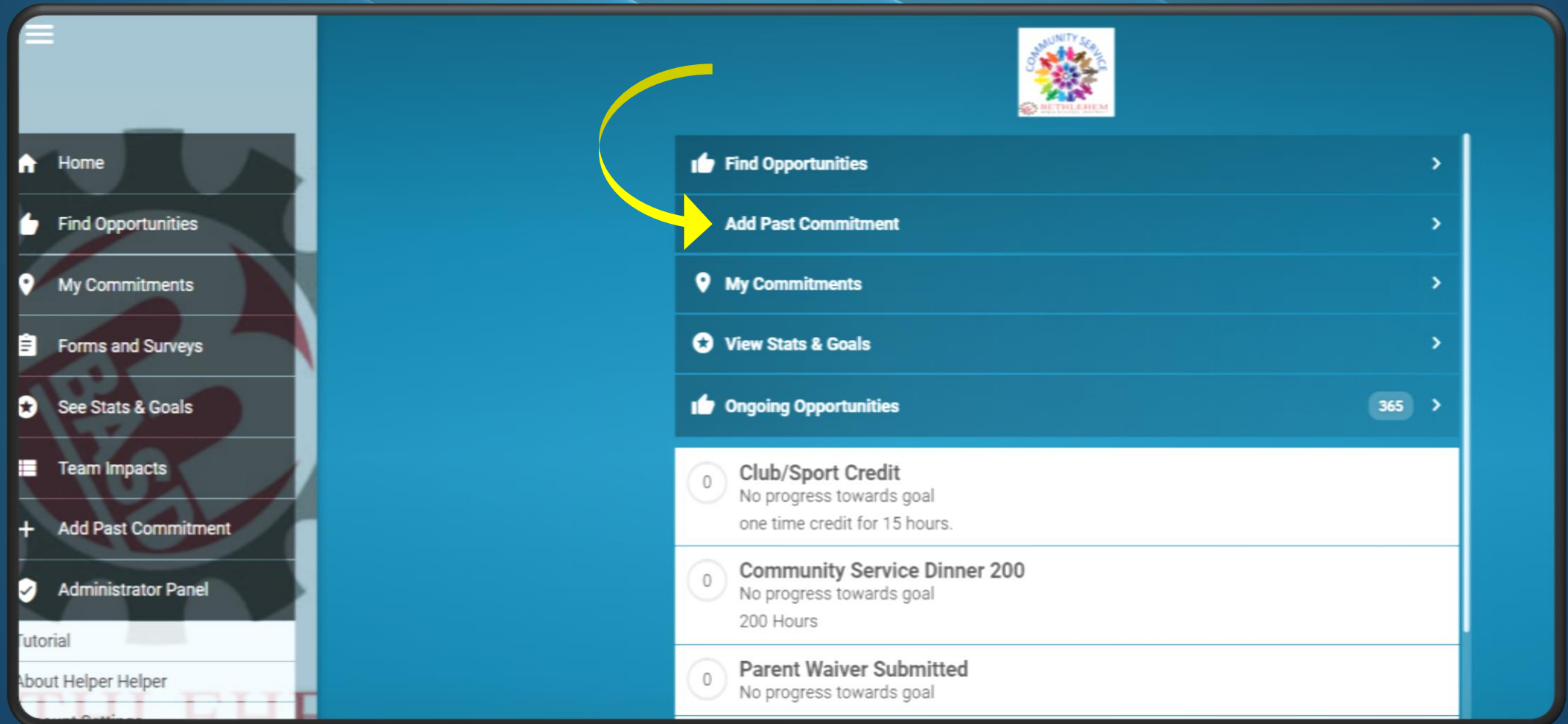



Club/Sports

If you completed a club or sport you will earn a one time 15 hours credit.

This is entered by the Community Service Office at the end of each season for sports and at the end of the year for clubs.

To know if they have been credited you can visit the “Goals” tab on your profile.

9th Grade Information
