



Student Accident Insurance

The Bethlehem Area School District provides insurance coverage to all student-athletes who participate in the approved sports program. The district also provides insurance coverage for expenses resulting from accidental injuries to students during gym class, recess, or while participating in interscholastic programs, i.e., marching band and cheerleading.

While the district offers coverage to all students, the insurance coverage of the parent or guardian is still "Primary" insurance coverage. Under the district's insurance program, the first \$100 of expenses for injuries will be paid regardless of other insurance. After the first \$100, the participant's own coverage will take over.

Students are urged to purchase the group accident coverage provided by the school district.

24-Hour Coverage (Accident Only) – This plan provides around-the-clock coverage to your child 24 hours a day, while he/she is in school, at home, or away. Coverage is provided from the effective date of the insured student's coverage for which premium has been received by A-G Administrators, LLC to the opening of the next school term. Excludes all interscholastic sports. (\$124.00)

School Time Coverage (Accident Only) – This plan provides coverage to your child while he/she is on school premises, during school hours/days, attending school-sponsored and supervised activities including travel directly without interruption between the student's residence and school/activity with transportation furnished by the school. Coverage is provided from the effective date of the insured student's coverage for which premium has been received by A-G Administrators, LLC to the end of the regular school term. Excludes all interscholastic sports. (\$28.00)
